

# The Request for fund-raising cooperation Taketa Christian Museum



NPO Corporation Taketa Christian Future Plan was approved in September 2016 for the purpose of "to revitalize Taketa City from the viewpoint of tourism through construction, survey and research of the Taketa Christian Museum."

Taketa was a former Christianity in the former "Eight Big Missionaries of Japan", and in the Sengoku period Don Paulo Shiga, in the Edo period Kiyohide Nakagawa 's second son ruled, so it is tolerant of missionary work What you can know from the valuable relics and relics remains today.

Kiyohide Nakagawa is a cousin of Ukon Takayama endorsed as "beatus," or "blessed," February 2017.

However, unfortunately there is no Christian Museum in Taketa City, so even if you own many valuable Christian relics and icon paintings, you can not see it for tourists except by the event.

Therefore, in order to solve this problem, NPO Corporation Taketa Christian Future Plan decided to open a Christian Museum by recruiting purification goods from everyone. The target amount is 7 million yen.

Inside, we plan to exhibit the Christian relics, which are only in Taketa worldwide, such as Santiago 's bell ,St. Jacob Stone statue, INRI stone monument, and many Icon Paintings. It is a plan to exhibit it while directing with Taketa's unique mystery and story.
